Terms and Conditions

- 1 All mares will be wormed on arrival and at regular intervals thereafter and the owner will be charged accordingly.
- 2 Veterinary assistance and advice will be obtained at the discretion of the staff on duty at the time. All expenses incurred for veterinary visits, examinations and medicines will be payable directly to the Veterinary Surgeon at the end of each month.
- 3 The farrier will be called at regular intervals whilst the mare is at stud and any costs incurred will be chargeable to the owner.
- 4 A negative blood test for EVA and Strangles must accompany the mare if they are visiting Twemlows Stud for AI
- 5 Mares will be accepted only with a passport and up-to-date Flu and Tetanus certification. Rules for the Equine Herpes injection as recommended by the Stud's Veterinary Surgeon.
 - a) Equine Herpes (EHV) injections will only be required for mares coming to Stud to foal down. Mares will need to have two injections with a one-month interval in between and two weeks to have expired from the second injection, before being allowed to come to Stud.
 - b) Mares with a happy, healthy foal at foot which is two weeks old or over and barren or maiden mares, will not need to have the EHV pneumabort injection.
- 6 The account for stud fees, keep fees and any other will be presented monthly and the balance outstanding must be paid before the mare is collected.
- 7 Every care will be taken whilst your mare is in our charge but no responsibility will be taken for accident, theft, injury or disease howsoever caused. Future Sport Horses accepts no liability for any claim, damage, cost, loss or expense of any kind howsoever incurred.
- 8 It is stud policy to scan all mares. If a mare leaves before being scanned it will be assumed that she is in foal and the fee is payable along with the keep fees before she leaves the stud.
- 9 Visiting mares and/or foals may not be removed from the stud until all accounts have been paid. Mare owners who send a third party to collect their mare should make arrangements to pay in advance of collection.
- 10 All mares must arrive with a head collar that they can be turned out in. Any rugs or other equipment arriving with the mare should be clearly labelled.
- 11 In respect of stallions that are promoted with a free return (NFFR), if the chosen stallion is no longer available, an alternative horse will be offered (original stud fee will be put to the new stallion and any refund/additional payment required will need to be made).
- 12 No VAT will charged on stud and livery fees
- 13 Livery Fees:
